The 2004 Quinta Sardonía is deep purple in color with an already complex perfume. Richer, deeper, and more succulent than the 2005, it has 6-8 years of aging potential. This pleasure-bent offering will drink well through 2029. The estate's full name is Vinas de la Vega del Duero but all you need to remember is Quinta Sardonía. Located in Sardon del Duero, just outside the Ribera del Duero demarcation line but close enough for inclusion in this report, Quinta Sardonía is a biodynamic project from Peter Sisseck (of Pingus fame) and Jerome Bougnaud. The estate has about 37 acres under vine planted in 2000. The wine is typically composed of a blend of roughly 50% Tempranillo, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, with the balance Merlot, Syrah, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, and Malbec with aging for 18 months in French oak.
